

ALL THINGS ARE POSSIBLE

Mark 10:27 “And Jesus looking upon them saith With men it is impossible, but not with God: for with God all things are possible”.

POSSIBILITY STEPS:

1. **Believe:** Mark 11:12 ¶ “And on the morrow, when they were come from Bethany, he was hungry; 3 And seeing a fig tree afar off having leaves, he came if haply he might find any thing thereon: and when he came to it, he found nothing but leaves; for the time of figs was not yet. Mt 21:19

3. ***Never give up on the way:*** John 19:30 “When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said It is finished and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost”.
